Brief history of CST Paonta Sahib:

Central school for Tibetans, Paonta is located at the Northern part of India at a town called Paonta Sahib, district Sirmour in Himachal Pradesh. The school was initially set up in 1968 as an immediate arrangement to provide education to the children of Tibetan Refugees settled at Bhuppur, Paonta Sahib (India) under administration of Tibetan Industrial Rehabilitation Society (TIRS) with 50 children from the settlement only. From its humble beginning in 1968 till today, the school has functioned under many different managements, each targeting for the betterment of this school with a sole aim of providing quality education to Tibetan Refugee Children in India.

The planning of the first phase of development of the school took its solid shape when the management of the school passed into the hands of the then Council for Tibetan Education (CTE), Dharamsala, now Department of Education, Central Tibetan Administration of His Holiness the Dalai Lama, Gangchen Kyishong, Dharamsala (India) At present, there are 34 teaching staff and 26 non-teaching staff against 481 students.

Brief history of TSTS Gangtok:

Regional Tibetan Youth Congress (RTYC) established Sambhota Tibetan School, Gangtok in 1980's but they couldn't continue the same for long time due to financial crunch and lack of technical personals. Finally, they requested the Department of Education to assume the full charge of the school. Therefore, in 1991 this school was taken under the Department of Education (DoE). Since then many development took place and few years back the school was shifted to new cite, with new school buildings. Currently, there are 16 teaching staff and 9 non-teaching staff against 205 students.

Project focus and need:

Therefore the need of literary resource development is highly felt by the department and proposed this enrichment program for your support and funding as these school library lacks quantity and variety of books to provide congenial self learning atmosphere.
